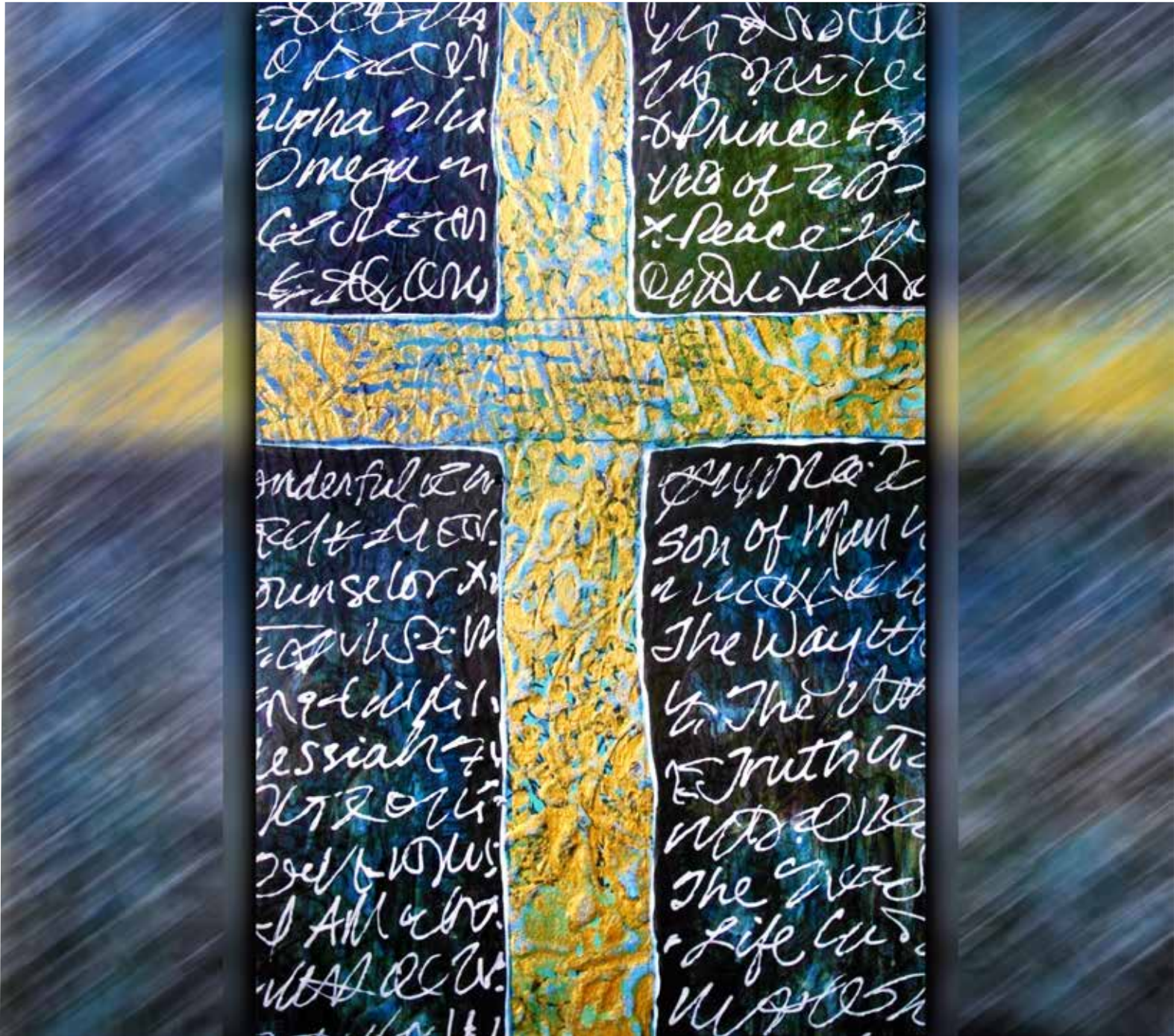

This past week saw Mario Day (Mar 10), Pi Day (3.14), and the Ides of March (3/15). While none of those days rise to the level of national holidays observed by droves of people, March is an important month in the history of this congregation. A group of Christians began meeting in Henderson in 1909 to follow the New Testament plan for the church. In 1938, a house at 1202 North Green Street was purchased, and the congregation began to worship there. It was March 14, 1943, when the church began meeting in the newly constructed building at this location. In more recent history, it was the third Sunday in March 2020 that we had our regular morning and evening worship services before everything closed for the pandemic. And it was also in March, a year later, that our Sunday nights and Wednesday nights returned to being in person.

March has been a big month for this congregation, and I'm excited to see what blessings God has in store for us in the future. Make this the month you commit to fully engaging with your church family in worship, Bible classes, and time spent together outside our scheduled assemblies. As Josh pointed out Wednesday night, God created the church as a body where all the members support one another. Making church family work for you is highly dependent on your level of involvement and commitment. The Young Adult Group will meet at 6:00 pm. See Clayton or Mallory Kramer if you have any questions.

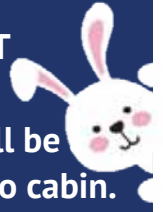
YOUTH GROUP
