


It was a Sunday morning when Jesus rode into Jerusalem to chants of "Hosanna! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!' The King of Israel!" The following Sunday, the women went to the tomb and found the stone rolled away. It was a Sunday when they heard the angels say, "Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but is risen!" It was a Sunday when the risen Lord first appeared to the disciples. It was the next Sunday when He appeared again to them.
