Before that, when many churches were closed, some local newspapers printed the text of the sermons that would have been delivered. Other churches mailed resources to each family to allow them to have a worship service, including sermon, at home, but they had to lead the service. These times we are living in now are not unprecedented, but I'm thankful for the advantages that modern technology has afforded us this time around. I join with so many others in praying for an end to this pandemic and may it be at least another century before the world deals with this again! Even if we're apart physically let's love one another and celebrate our worship as gather as on in spirit!
