Our communion is an open communion - it is designed for Christians but we permit anyone to take it who feels it is appropriate.

May we always remember that at the heart of our faith is a debt that was paid for us by the sacrifice of Jesus. That has forever changed our world personally and the whole world. The gospel is for everyone and we are charged with making sure the world never forgets what God has done for us!
